The AFTRS Executive Scholarship Fund

Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to expand and enrich the school's student community by supporting a student relocating from an interstate and/or a regional or remote area to take up their place in the Master of Arts Screen or Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production or Graduate Diploma in Radio.

The successful applicant will be selected on the basis of a demonstrated need.

This scholarship will provide up to \$5000 as well as one return flight from Sydney to their hometown. The scholarship is intended to support commencing and returning students with their studies by providing a contribution to a living allowance or towards relocation costs, study resources, fees or other costs.

At least two scholarships will be awarded in 2021 and the recipients cannot defer the commencement of the scholarship.

Payments

This scholarship is made available via funds provided by the AFTRS Executive hardship fund.

The scholarship is valued up to \$5000, to be paid following the applicable census date. Payments are conditional on the recipient remaining enrolled, in good academic standing, and continuing to meet the eligibility criteria, and any other conditions.

Assessment of applications

The scholarship is intended to support students relocating to Sydney to take up their place in the course. Students from low socio-economic backgrounds or who can demonstrate financial hardship are encouraged to apply. You will be asked to provide a statement about who you are and what the scholarship will do for you.

At least two scholarships will be awarded in 2021 and so AFTRS may not be able to support everyone who applies or who demonstrates they are in need. AFTRS will determine which, if any, applicants will be awarded a scholarship. AFTRS' decision is final and correspondence about decisions will not be entered into. Successful applicants will be told of any conditions of a scholarship.

MA Screen or BA Screen: Production or Graduate Diploma in Radio

The committee will take into consideration the statement provided by the applicant along with any other material regarding their financial or other need. Applicants are asked to self-identify when making an application, but may be required to supply documentation on request.

In the event of there being no suitable applicants for that year the committee will convene to determine a course of action. The recipient cannot defer the commencement of the scholarship.

Who can apply?

This scholarship is open to new and returning students.

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship, you must:

- For new students, complete an application submission for the Master of Arts Screen or Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production or Graduate Diploma in Radio
- For returning students, be enrolled and eligible to commence study in 2021
- Be an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident or a New Zealand citizen
- Reside in an interstate and/or a regional or remote area.

To be eligible to receive the scholarship, you must:

- Be accepted and enrolled into the Master of Arts Screen or Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production or Graduate Diploma in Radio course.

How to Apply

Application dates

Applications open Monday 17 August 2020 and close Monday 9 November 2020.

Supporting documents must be submitted to AFTRS by the closing date. You will be notified by email whether or not your application is successful.

Scholarship applications are separate to course applications. To be eligible for a scholarship, you must have been offered a place in the Master of Arts Screen or Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production or Graduate Diploma in Radio course, so it is important that you apply for the course as well as apply for the scholarship. Complete the scholarship application form and provide any documentation requested by the closing date.
