Atlas Shorts Screen Excellence Scholarship

Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to support the telling of diverse Australian stories by providing a financial scholarship for a commencing student in 2022 in the Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production. The application will be selected on the basis of creative excellence.

The Atlas Shorts Screen Excellence Scholarship will be awarded to support a student's first year of their course by awarding them \$10,000.

One scholarship may be offered in 2022 to a Bachelor of Arts Screen : Production student after consideration by the selection committee. The recipient cannot defer the commencement of the scholarship.

Payments

The scholarship is valued at \$10,000.

\$10,000 will be awarded to a student commencing the Bachelor of Arts: Screen Production in 2022.

The scholarship payment will be paid in two equal installments following the applicable census dates. Payments are conditional on the recipient remaining enrolled, in good academic standing, and continuing to meet the eligibility criteria, and any other conditions.

Assessment of applications

The application will be selected on the basis of creative excellence.

AFTRS will determine which, if any, applicants will be awarded a scholarship. AFTRS' decision is final and correspondence about decisions will not be entered into. The successful applicant will be told of any conditions of a scholarship. If the selection panel finds that no applicant meets the criteria, a scholarship will not be awarded.

The selection panel will take into consideration the material provided by the applicant and select a recipient based on the following:

- Distinct point of view
- Originality

Who can apply?

This scholarship is open to new students.

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship, you must:

- Complete an application submission for the Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production.
- Be an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident or a New Zealand citizen.

To be eligible to receive the fee scholarship, you must:

- Be accepted into the Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production.

How to Apply

Application dates

Applications open Monday 23rd August and close Monday 25th October 2021.

Supporting documents must be submitted to AFTRS by the closing date. You will be notified by email whether or not your application is successful.

Applications for the Atlas Shorts Screen Excellence Scholarship are separate to course applications. To be eligible for a scholarship, you must have been offered a place in the Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production so it is important that you apply for the course as well as apply for the scholarship.

Complete the scholarship application form and provide any documentation requested by the closing date.

Application Task

To demonstrate your creative excellence in storytelling, please complete the two tasks.

1. Creative Work

Storytelling takes many forms. You can demonstrate your ability by submitting work in one of several formats. It is strongly recommended that you submit the same work as you have for your BA Application Creative Work.

The parameters for submission are:

Script – 4-5 pages max
Film Or Audio-Visual Content (6-7 Minutes Max)
Portfolio of Photos Or Drawings (4-6 Pages/
Images Max)

2. Personal Statement

Please submit a personal statement that describes why you want to tell stories and explains the basis of the work you have submitted. This should be no more than 500 words.

Certification of documentation provided

Any documents you provide as support material must be certified copies. AFTRS' certification requirements are available at:

Translation of documents provided

If supporting documents are not in English, applicants are required to supply certified copies of the following:

- The document in the original language; and
- An English translation of the document by an accredited translator. Do not send original supporting documents.
