Introduction

This document provides a summary of all higher education fees and associated information (study periods, census dates, credit points and EFTSL values) for subjects undertaken in courses of study at AFTRS in 2023. This document includes information relating to domestic students and overseas students.

Tuition Fees

- In accordance with regulatory compliance, all tuition fees are generated on a 'per unit of study' basis. AFTRS defines a 'unit of study' as a subject.
- AFTRS determines that the standard full-time study load is 48 credit points for one year (or 24 credit points for one semester).
- All tuition fees are listed on the basis of a standard full-time or part-time study load equivalent to the study mode permitted in the course.
- The tuition fees are reviewed each year and you are liable for the additional tuition costs if the tuition fees rise during the course of your enrolment.
- Each subject is assigned a study period and census date.
- Financial penalties will apply to students who withdraw from their course after midnight on the relevant census date.
- An administrative fee of \$500 AUD will apply to any international student who withdraws from a course prior to a census date where a refund of fees paid is due (exemptions apply).

Block-Based Study Periods

AFTRS uses a 'block' timetabling approach in the delivery of its subjects. This means that not all subjects are delivered throughout the entirety of the semester, but instead delivered in blocks.

For these subjects, a study period may occur over a period of weeks within the semester and an applicable census date will be applied accordingly.

Further information regarding the delivery of the subjects in your course will be supplied once you are enrolled and your personalised timetable is supplied to you.

2023 Standard Semesters

AFTRS higher education academic year consists of two semesters. The Bachelor of Arts Screen: Production operates on a staggered semester pattern that deviates from the Standard Semester structure. See next page for complete 2023 Academic Year.

Glossary of Terms

AQF: The Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) that sets out the standards of education and qualifications across Australia

Blended: Blended mode, or 'multi-modal' is the mode of delivery whereby teaching is delivered in both internal mode (on campus) and external mode (online). Students must participate in both modes throughout the subject.

Census Date: The date after which a student incurs a financial debt for the subject in which they are enrolled

Core Subject: A subject that is required to be completed within an award course

Credit Point: Credit points are a means of identifying the relative value of a subject. It is used in the calculation of an EFTSL.

Domestic student: A student who is not an overseas student

EFTSL: Equivalent Full-Time Student Load. A full-time study load is defined as 1 EFTSL for one year. Each subject has an associated EFTSL value.

Elective Subject: A non-core subject that the student may choose to complete to meet the course completion requirements

FEE-HELP: Australian Government loan program to help eligible fee-paying students to pay their tuition fees, up to a lifetime limit, for eligible courses at approved higher education providers. The loan is repaid through the Australian Government taxation system once a graduate's income reaches the minimum threshold for compulsory repayment.

Full-time (FT): A semester study load of 18 credit points or more

Incidental Fees: Food, transport and accommodation costs associated with the provision of field trips that form part of the course. Mandatory for specified subjects.

Indicative Course Fee: The indicative fee is the approved course fee for the academic year that this document pertains to. The indicative fee does not represent the final fee for the duration of the course, as it is subject to change year-to-year.

Intake: A course commencement point where new students enter a course

Mode of Delivery: The method that a subject is taught (*see also*; blended, on campus, and online)

Mode of Study: The study load that corresponds to a students' enrollment (*see also*; part-time and full-time)

Campus: Campus mode refers to the mode of delivery whereby teaching is delivered fully on campus and in person

Offshore: The method of study when a student is not based in Australia and undertakes learning fully online

Online: Online mode refers to the mode of delivery whereby teaching is delivered fully online

Onshore: The method of study when a student is based in Australia

Overseas Student: A student who is not an Australian citizen. Overseas students *do not* include: a person entitled to stay in Australia, or enter and stay in Australia, without any limitation as to time (including holders of an Australian permanent visa) or New Zealand citizens. Overseas students must not complete more than 33% of their course online, and they must enrol in all available subjects each semester at a full-time study load.

Part-time (PT): A semester study load of 12 credit points or fewer

Student Type: The identifier for how a student undertakes their study; In Australia or not in Australia, and in combination with their citizenship status (domestic or overseas)

Study Load: The measure of credit points and EFTSL that a student is required to undertake. Study load is not a fixed status, and may change each semester based on a student's subject enrolments.

Study Period: The formal teaching period for a subject

Tuition Fee: A provider must require every student who is enrolled in a subject, who is not Commonwealth supported, and who is not an exempt student, to pay a tuition fee for the subject

Upfront: The fee payment method by which a student is required to pay their fees on a semester-by-semester basis
