Introduction

This document provides a summary of AFTRS higher education fees and associated structural information about AFTRS courses and subjects.

This document includes information relating to undergraduate and postgraduate students, and domestic and overseas students.

In reading the content of this document students should note that:

- in accordance with regulatory compliance, all tuition fees are generated on a 'per unit of study' basis. AFTRS defines a 'unit of study' as a subject.
- AFTRS determines that the standard full-time study load is 48 credit points and 1.000 EFTSL for one year (or 24 credit points/ 0.5000 EFTSL for one semester)
- tuition fees are reviewed each year by the AFTRS Council and students may be liable for any additional tuition costs if the tuition fees change during the course of their enrolment
- each subject is assigned a study period and census date, and census dates should be considered separately for each subject when students are taking a decision to withdraw
- financial penalties will apply to students who withdraw from their course after midnight on the relevant census date
- an administrative fee of \$500 (AUD) will apply to any overseas student who withdraws from a subject prior to a census date where a refund of fees paid is due (exemptions apply)
- for further information regarding fees, including applicable refunds, refer to the Fees Policy

Payment of Tuition Fees

Students may have options to pay their tuition fees based on their citizenship, mode of attendance and their available HELP balance. The two payment options for AFTRS course tuition fees are FEE-HELP and upfront. A student may choose to utilise one or both options.

- <u>FEE-HELP</u>- the Australian Government loan program to help eligible fee-paying students to pay their tuition fees, up to a lifetime limit, for eligible courses at approved higher education providers. To be eligible, a student must be a domestic student based in Australia.
- <u>Upfront</u> where a student is required to pay their fees on a semesterby-semester basis. Invoices will be issued by AFTRS directly to the student. Upfront tuition fee payments are due by the upfront administration date or two weeks after an invoice has been issued through the Paradigm, whichever date is later. Payment of upfront fees can be made in the <u>A Paradigm Portal</u>.

Block-Based Study Periods (Subjects)

AFTRS uses a 'block' timetabling approach in the delivery of its subjects. This means that not all subjects are delivered throughout the entirety of the semester, but instead delivered in blocks.

For these subjects, a study period may occur over a period of weeks within the semester and an applicable census date will be applied accordingly.

Further information regarding the delivery of the subjects in your course will be supplied once you are enrolled and your personalised timetable is supplied to you.

Glossary of Key Terms

<u>Candidature Period</u>– the maximum amount of time that a student is allowed to complete their course requirements

<u>Census Date</u>– the date after which a student incurs a financial debt for the subject in which they are enrolled. Students may withdraw from a subject on or before this date without incurring financial or academic penalties.

<u>Credit Point</u> – credit points represent the relative value of a subject as a portion of the course. Credit points determine the volume of learning (hours) for a subject. Credit points are also used in the calculation of the EFTSL value and the tuition fee amount.

<u>Discipline</u>— a specialist focus of a course that determines which core subjects students undertake when there are two or more mutually-exclusive options. Disciplines are determined at course application and cannot be changed.

<u>EFTSL</u> – Equivalent Full-Time Student Load is a measure of a student's annual study load. A students' EFTSL is calculated by summing the EFTSL value for each subject that the student undertakes within the calendar year. Each subject has an associated EFTSL value.

Incidental Fees— food, transport and accommodation costs associated with the provision of field trips that form part of the course. This fee is mandatory for specified subjects and is not payable by FEE-HELP.

<u>Indicative Course Fee</u>– the indicative course fee is the total course fee in the calendar year that this document pertains to. The indicative fee is subject to change year-to-year. This indicative course fee determines the cost of each subject on a year-to-year basis.

Intake – the course commencement method by which a new student enters a course. Students can enter a course in semester 1 or semester 2, depending on each courses' approved intakes each year.

- Articulation entry into an advanced stage of a course by a formal agreement between AFTRS and another provider
- Standard- entry into the beginning of the course

<u>Mode of Attendance</u>– the indicator representing a student's physical location whilst undertaking study

- Offshore
 – a student that is based outside of Australia for the duration
 of their study
- Onshore

 a student that is based in Australia for the duration of their study

<u>Mode of Delivery</u>– all courses and subjects have one or more modes of delivery. The modes of delivery for a course are determined by the cumulative modes of delivery for the subjects within that course. The modes of delivery for a subject identify the ways that it can be delivered to students.

- o External- the delivery of teaching fully-online
- Internal— the delivery of teaching face-to-face and in person. This includes non-campus based teaching that occurs off-site
- Multi Modal

 the delivery of teaching using both face-to-face and online learning. All face-to-face and online learning activities must be engaged with, and the student cannot elect to participate in only one or the other

Mode of Study– an indicator determined by a student's EFTSL as a percentage of the maximum EFTSL for the current semester

- Full-time- 75% or more of the course's EFTSL
- Part-time- less than 75% of the course's EFTSL

Student Type - the indicator representing a student's citizenship status

- Domestic- a student who is not an overseas student
- Overseas
 – a student who is not an Australian citizen, a person entitled
 to enter and stay in Australia without any limitation as to time (including
 holders of an Australian permanent visa) or a person who is a New
 Zealand citizen

 $\underline{\text{Semester}}\text{-} \text{ the formal teaching periods for a course within a calendar year.}$ AFTRS has two semesters each calendar year.

<u>Study Period</u> – the formal teaching period for a subject within a semester. Each subject is allocated its own study period based on its start date and end date

 $\underline{Subject\ Type} - \ the\ indicator\ representing\ the\ requirements\ for\ a\ student\ to\ complete\ a\ subject$

- o Core- a subject that must be completed
- Core (Discipline)

 a core subject that is part of a set of mutually exclusive subjects where only one can be completed, determined by the student's course discipline
- Elective- a subject that the student may choose to complete
- Elective X- an elective subject that is part of a group of mutually exclusive subjects, where X identifies the subjects in that group. A single semester may have more than one group of electives that each require subject selections. A subject that is not chosen in one group can be chosen in another. A course may offer all of its electives into a single group, indicating that only one elective can be completed for the duration of the course.

<u>Tuition Fee</u>– a provider must require every student who is enrolled in a subject, who is not Commonwealth supported, and who is not an exempt student, to pay a tuition fee for the subject
